
RECENTLY THERE SEEMS TO BE A FEW ACCESSORY BUILDINGS, FENCING, SPORT COURTS, AND EVEN HOME CONSTRUCTION, ALL STARTED ON LOTS WITHOUT ANY CITY APPROVAL OR PERMITS BEING ISSUED, ETC. ALL OF THIS IS IN VIOLATION OF OUR CITY ORDINANCES AND FINES CAN BE LEVIED AGAINST THE VARIOUS PROPERTY OWNERS FOR THEIR NONCOMPLIANCE. IT IS LIKELY THAT SOME OF THIS IS INNOCENTLY DONE, MEANING LACK OF KNOWLEDGE OF OUR CITY ORDINANCE REQUIREMENTS, BUT AS THEY SAY, IGNORANCE OF THE LAW IS NO EXCUSE. OUR ORDINANCES ALSO ALLOW FOR MISDEMEANOR CHARGES TO BE BROUGHT AGAINST THE VIOLATOR AS WELL. ALL OF OUR ORDINANCES ARE ONLINE AND AVAILABLE FOR ANY RESIDENT, OR OTHERS, TO LOOK AT AND BETTER UNDERSTAND WHAT OUR ORDINANCES SAY AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF EACH. WE DO GET PERIODIC INQUIRIES FROM RESIDENTS WHO HAVE LOOKED AT THEM AND HAVE FURTHER QUESTIONS ABOUT THEM. WE WELCOME THESE CALLS AS IT SAVES OUR TIME AND OFTEN THE RESIDENT'S TIME IN THE PROCESS, TO AVOID REDO'S WHEN DONE.

ANOTHER AREA THAT GETS VIOLATED QUITE OFTEN BY A FEW IS THE PLACING OF SIGNS IN THE CITY RIGHT OF WAY. THE RIGHT OF WAY EXTENDS TO AROUND 15 FEET BEYOND THE ROAD ASPHALT ON EACH SIDE OF THE ROAD. THERE ARE NO SIGNS ALLOWED IN THIS AREA EXCEPT CITY SIGNS, USUALLY ROAD SIGNS. WE WOULD HOPE THAT ALL WOULD RESPECT THIS. IF YOU DON'T LIKE AN ORDINANCE, COME TO CITY COUNCIL AND ASK THEM TO CHANGE IT AND GIVE THEM A GOOD REASON TO DO SO. PAST AND PRESENT CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS ARE THE ONES WHO HAVE IMPLEMENTED THE ORDINANCES AND ONLY THEY CAN CHANGE THEM. THEY COMPRISE OUR LEGISLATURE FOR THE CITY. WHILE SOME GET UPSET IF WE DON'T ENFORCE OUR ORDINANCES (AND RIGHTFULLY SO) WHILE OTHERS GET UPSET WHEN WE DO ENFORCE THEM. SO LET'S ALL WORK ON KEEPING OUR CITY ORDINANCES AND BE GOOD NEIGHBORS TO THOSE AROUND US. HOPE ALL HAVE A WONDERFUL HOLIDAY SEASON.

TED TALKS PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT

RECENTLY, THE CITY COMPLETED A PAVEMENT PRESERVATION STUDY. THIS STUDY ANALYZED THE CONDITION OF ALL CITY ROADS USING AI TECHNOLOGY AND THEN CLASSIFIED THEM BASED ON THEIR CONDITION. ONCE THE CONDITION OF THE EXISTING ROADS WAS ESTABLISHED, THE APPROPRIATE TREATMENT FOR THEM WAS DETERMINED, RANGING FROM PRESERVATION TREATMENTS TO FULL PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT. THE PRESERVATION PROJECTS WERE PRIORITIZED, AND BUDGETARY COSTS WERE PREPARED.

OVER THE NEXT SEVERAL YEARS, THE CITY WILL BE SYSTEMATICALLY COMPLETING THESE PROJECTS TO PRESERVE AND REBUILD THE APPROXIMATELY 17 MILES OF CITY ROADS. THE FIRST OF THESE PROJECTS WILL BEGIN THIS SPRING AND WILL INCLUDE SEALING (MICRO SURFACING) APPROXIMATELY 4 MILES OF ROADWAY THAT WERE RECONSTRUCTED WITH THE WATERLINE PROJECT AND ARE STILL IN GOOD CONDITION. I REALIZE IT SEEMS COUNTERINTUITIVE TO PRIORITIZE ROAD PROJECTS BY STARTING WITH THE BEST ROADS AND SAVING THE WORST ROADS FOR LAST. THE PURPOSE OF PAVEMENT PRESERVATION IS TO PROACTIVELY MAINTAIN ROADS IN GOOD CONDITION BY APPLYING LOW-COST TREATMENTS TO EXTEND THE LIFE OF THE PAVEMENT AND MINIMIZE THE NEED FOR COSTLY REPAIRS OR RECONSTRUCTION ON THESE ROADS. THIS APPROACH MAXIMIZES THE RETURN ON INVESTMENT IN ROADWAY BUDGETING. IN OTHER WORDS, PRESERVING THE GOOD ROADS FIRST WILL PRESERVE THEM LONGER AND GIVE US TIME TO COMPLETE THE WORST ROADS WITHOUT THE GOOD ROADS DEGRADING BEYOND A LESS EXPENSIVE FUTURE TREATMENT. WE WILL STILL DO MAINTENANCE/REPAIR WORK, AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, ON THE WORST ROADS UNTIL THEY CAN BE REPLACED. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THE PROJECT, PLEASE FEEL FREE TO REACH OUT TO ME.
